### Information from the Government

Following the Government announcement last weekend, school are trying to work through the information that is being sent on a daily basis.

The Government's plan for the remainder of the summer term stipulated:

*"From 1 June 2020, we expect that secondary schools and colleges will be able to offer some face to face contact with year 10 and year 12 pupils. This will not be a return to full timetables or pupils back in school or college full time, rather some support to supplement pupils' remote education"*

Yesterday, we sent a survey to the parents of pupils in Years 10 and 12 to gather their thoughts on a proposed return to school. Whilst we are in the initial stages of this planning, we would appreciate it if as many parents of pupils in Years 10 and 12 would complete this survey by **9.00am on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May**. We will survey the rest of the school community in the coming weeks. I can assure you that our plans will prioritise the health and well-being of our pupils and staff.

### Microsoft Teams

From Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May, we will be rolling out the use of Microsoft Teams with Year 10, as well as Year 12. The aim is for pupils to receive one of these lessons per week, per subject. Teachers will be putting the dates and times of the Microsoft Teams lessons on PARS to advise the pupils as to when these will take place. Please note, work will still be set on PARS each week to be completed. We have also attached the Microsoft Teams Guide for Students. We will review our remote learning again after half-term.
