Staff tried to make phone calls where possible, but I appreciate this was not a perfect system.

The new software was purchased to enable us to hold a productive evening of feedback and communication despite the lockdown. We have used this software twice before with Year 13 and Year 11 and have been very pleased with the service. However, Wednesday evening was disrupted by technical issues, with the software company, that we had no control of.
