Enrichment Week

Next week, our attention returns to the non-academic aspects of school life as Year 11 enjoy an enrichment week. Attendance is mandatory. The details of this are as follows:

Pupils should arrive in school no later than 9am each day. If they arrive before 8.50am, but no earlier than 8.30am, they are welcome to gather in the canteen. After 8.50am, they should go directly to their form room. 11John's form room will be M1.3 during this week. All other form rooms remain unchanged. They will be in school until 1.20pm each day when they will be dismissed to go home. On Friday 28th May, pupils will have an early finish and only need to be in school between 9am and 11am.

Each day, pupils need to wear full school uniform. The blue summer shirt can be worn, and all other rules remain the same. On Thursday 28th May, pupils may wear their PE kit which will be more suitable for some of the afternoon activities.

In terms of equipment, they will need a pair of wired headphones as well as the usual writing equipment. They will not need to bring any books or work.

During the course of the week, pupils will follow a carousel of activities. Some will be delivered by staff in school, such as workshops on important elements of personal health, and others will be delivered by external providers, for example the National Citizenship Service or West Midlands police. All pupils will take part in a careers lesson and some pupils will be given the opportunity to attend a virtual mock interview with an external interviewer. Pupils who have not had a Sixth Form interview will be prioritised for this opportunity. Pupils might find it useful to read through some practice questions online to help them prepare for a possible interview.

On Tuesday, Year 11 will gather in the Sports Hall for a special Thanksgiving Mass which Fr Austin Hughes will celebrate. We will be giving thanks to God for the wonderful young people that have graced our Year 11 class of 2021 and pray for their future success, safety and happiness. We are working on the possibility of trying to live stream this for parents. On Friday, Mr Seickell has planned a special Celebration Assembly to recognise the hard work and talents of an excellent year group.



Between 7th and 18th June, pupils will not need to attend school physically each day but there will be other opportunities happening remotely. Our Careers Team will be sending a separate letter regarding the details of this.

Pupils who have applied to our Sixth Form should make sure the dates of 21st – 23rd June are in their diaries as we plan to hold a series of induction activities for what will be a new Year 12.
