Enrichment Week

It has been wonderful to have Year 13 pupils in school this week, taking part in 'masterclasses' in their chosen subjects. Staff have commented about how much they have enjoyed enriching the experience of our Advanced level pupils. These classes will continue to take place up to and including Monday 24th May.

Attendance continues to be mandatory. On Tuesday and Wednesday, our attention refocuses on our non-academic priorities. The details for Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday of next week are as follows:

Pupils should arrive in school no later than 8.45am each day and head to their form room. They will be in school until 3pm on Tuesday and Wednesday. On Thursday 27th May, pupils will have an early finish and only need to be in school between 9am and 11am.

Each day, pupils need follow the normal Sixth Form Dress code. On Wednesday 26th May, pupils may wear sports clothes which will be more suitable for some of the afternoon activities.

In terms of equipment, they may need a pair of wired headphones as well as the usual writing equipment. They will not need to bring any books or work.

Over the week, pupils will follow a carousel of activities. Sessions will focus on essential life education. All pupils will take part in a finance lesson and a cookery session for example, and some pupils will be given the opportunity to attend a virtual mock interview with an external interviewer. Our Careers Team have already emailed pupils directly to give them the opportunity to participate in a mock interview – pupils need to reply to this in order to secure an interview place. Pupils might find it useful to read through some practice questions online to help them prepare for a possible interview.

On Tuesday, Year 13 will gather in the Sports Hall for a special Thanksgiving Mass which Fr Austin Hughes will celebrate. We will be giving thanks to God for the wonderful young people that have graced our Year 13 class of 2021 and pray for their future success, safety and happiness. We are working on the possibility of trying to live stream this for parents. On Thursday, Mrs McHale has planned a special Celebration Assembly to recognise the hard work and talents of an excellent year group.



Between 7th and 18th June, pupils will not need to attend school physically each day but there will be other opportunities happening remotely. Our Careers Team will be sending a separate letter regarding the details of this.
